Dr Stephen Proud MBBS, FRANZCP, FACHAM is the Director of Psychiatry at Healthe Care Australia's Abbotsford Private Hospital and Blackwood River Clinic. He is Consultant Psychiatrist who operates private psychiatric practices in Perth and Bunbury in the South West of Western Australia.

Dr Proud has specific interests in General Adult Psychiatry, Addiction Psychiatry, Forensic Psychiatry, Old Age Psychiatry, and Spiritual and Psychotherapy based Psychiatry. He offers specialised treatment for Anxiety, Depression, PTSD and Bipolar Disorder, and also offers Medico Legal Assessments.

After graduating from the University of WA Medical School in 1980 (MBBS), in 1994, he completed a Graduate Diploma in Environmental Science at Murdoch University WA before obtaining his Fellowship with the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Psychiatrists (RANZCP) in 1999.

Dr Proud worked as a GP in India, South Africa and in 1994 underwent rural and metropolitan Western Australia retraining in Psychiatry.

He has held key academic positions including Lecturer in Neuroscience and Foundation Director of The Old Age Psychiatry Training Program in WA, Past Supervisor of Psychiatrists in Training WA, Past Clinical Head of North Metropolitan Old Age Psychiatry WA and Past Clinical Head of WANADA (WA Network of Alcohol and Drug Associations). He is a Member of the Faculty of Forensic Psychiatry, Foundation Member of the Faculty of Addiction Medicine and Member of the Faculty of Addiction Psychiatry.

Dr Proud also started up Abbotsford Private Hospital as Western Australia's only dedicated private hospital specialising in dual diagnosis, as well as Blackwood River Clinic as a private rural retreat day hospital.
